





NOTES ■ South Stand is away area. ■ West Stand Middle Tier and part of East Stand central area are for 1901 Club members. ■ East Stand (south) will be offered to away supporters for cup matches in accordance with FA regulations. ■ Concessions represent discounts of 30% (senior), 50% (under 18) and 75% (under 10). ■ Deposit equal to one monthly payment is payable on reservation. ■ Disabled supporters will be charged the season ticket price for the area in which they bought their ticket; personal assistants meeting a proven matchday need will be admitted free of charge.

Season tickets will soon be going on sale for 2011/12, the opening season at the brilliant American Express Community Stadium.

We're giving priority to our loyal season ticket holders, each of whom (except under-16s) will be given the opportunity to buy up to three further tickets for family and friends.

We're inviting you to the Amex Stadium for bespoke presentations; thrilling events to help you make up your mind about where you would like to sit. Each presentation will be limited to 40 guests to ensure that everyone gets the personal attention they need.

We're holding presentations on days and times to suit everyone. Because there are over 4,000 season ticket holders at Withdean the presentations will be scheduled according to the simple list of factors shown on the right.

There is no right or wrong way of doing this, but the important thing is...

...every seat at the Amex Stadium will offer a wonderful view. And with 15,000 available, there will be plenty for our existing season ticket holders to choose from.

CURRENT TICKET HOLDERS GUARANTEED AN AMEX STADIUM SEAT

When you call the hotline we'll arrange a convenient time for your presentation according to the schedule shown below.

Priority 1. Those who have had Withdean season tickets for nine years or more or have bought a multi-year season ticket for nine years or more. *These supporters will be invited to the presentations in seating block order to help ensure that people who sit near to each other at Withdean can continue to do so.*

Priority 2. Season ticket holders who have helped the club in extra ways - for example those who made contributions to the Alive & Kicking fundraising appeal or who joined our litter-picking teams at Withdean. *There are about 450 such supporters but of course many are already included under priority 1.*

Priority 3. Disabled season ticket holders & BODS members. *We have about 150 such supporters and they will be first in the queue for disability seating at the American Express Community Stadium.*

Priority 4. Other season ticket holders. We have about 2,000 who are not included in categories 1, 2 and 3. *We considered sending invitations to these ticket holders according to how long they have held tickets but doing so would discriminate against younger supporters - and again mean that many people who sit together at Withdean would no longer be able to. So invitations will be issued in seating block order.*

Q&A

THE BEST WAY TO CHOOSE YOUR TICKET?

We considered three ways our supporters could choose their season tickets.

- 1. Post 2. Online 3. By personal visit

The problems with the first two methods are that the personal touch will be missing, individual queries will be difficult to resolve and supporters might not have all the information they want.

So we're going to do it face-to-face, with friendly personal meetings that answer individual questions. This was the system chosen by Arsenal and after considering all the options we think it's right for us too.

But if any supporter finds it impossible to get to a presentation we will help by phone or email during the allocated priority period.

WHEN WILL PRESENTATIONS TAKE PLACE?

From early January, throughout the day and evening.

There will be up to four presentations daily in order to meet everyone's needs. When you call the Ticket Holders' Hotline we will agree a date and time convenient to you. You will then be sent a prestigious boxed order pack, including your personal Privilege Card and forms to complete and bring to the presentation.

HOW WILL I PAY FOR MY TICKET?

We're determined to have a simple, affordable system.

Supporters will be asked to pay a deposit equivalent to one month's instalment when making their booking. They can then buy their tickets by monthly direct debit from March 2011 or with a single payment in April 2011.

The monthly payment scheme can be renewed annually.

HOW CAN FRIENDS KEEP TOGETHER?

We have made it possible in two ways:

- 1. By allowing each existing season ticket holder to buy up to three extra tickets.
- 2. By inviting most ticket holders to presentations in seating block order - so that people who sit together will have the best opportunity of buying their future tickets together.

HOW DO PRICES COMPARE TO WITHDEAN?

There are six pricing zones at the Amex Stadium, some of which are the same price as, or cheaper than, equivalent areas at Withdean. The centre of the West Stand lower tier has a higher price point but will provide a totally different match-day experience.

Optional public transport ticket vouchers will also be available, their price subsidised by the Albion.
